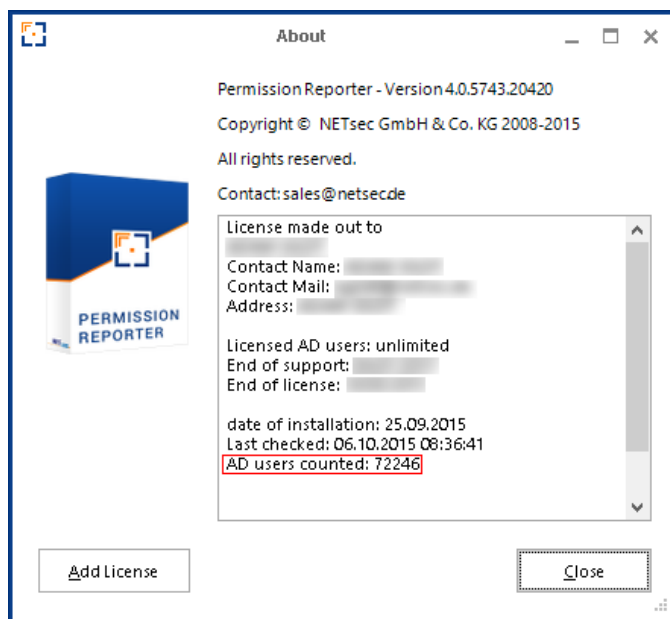


PERMISSION REPORTER[®] LICENSING

How to determine Active Directory Users

Permission Reporter licensing is based on the count of enabled users inside an Active Directory.

If you have Permission Reporter installed in your environment, you will find the current user count by clicking on "Show License" inside the *Global Config* Context of Permission Reporter.



If the program isn't installed you can resolve the count of activated users by using the Microsoft Windows-PowerShell-Prompt. The following command will show you the amount of enabled users inside the current Active Directory, in which you are logged in with your user account.

```
$objForest = [System.DirectoryServices.ActiveDirectory.Forest]::GetCurrentForest()
$globalCatalog = $objForest.FindGlobalCatalog()
$s = $globalCatalog.GetDirectorySearcher()
$s.PageSize = 200
$s.PropertiesToLoad.Clear()
$result = $s.PropertiesToLoad.Add("distinguishedName")

$s.Filter = "(&(objectClass=user)(objectCategory=person)(!(UserAccountControl:1.2.840.113556.1.4.803:=2)))"

$results = $s.FindAll().Count

$results
```
